





Mandatory Procedures


The following are <u>mandatory procedures</u> students need to take care of. Procedures need to be completed at your local city hall/branch office/ward office. Read through "2-2 Complete the following procedures at the ward office" for details, and take note of the specifics (if any) mentioned for your campus.

- **1** Registering your Address
- 2 Enrolling in National Health Insurance
- **3 Enrolling in National Pension**

Residence Card

Your residence card must be carried at all times.

Failure to carry may result in a fine of up to 200,000 yen, and failure to present it to an immigration inspector, immigration security officer, or police officer may result in imprisonment for up to one year or a fine of up to 200,000 yen.

A "Student" residence status is granted for conducting study and research.

Your address will be registered by submitting a notification of moving out or moving in to the ward office or city hall, or branch office where you live.

Residence Card

Status of Residence



You are responsible

- Keep track of your <u>period of stay (date of expiration)</u>
- Apply for extension before the expiration date. For details
 - * You can apply 3 months before your period of stay expires.
 - **X** Apply at the Immigration Bureau with documents prepared in advance.
 - **Mathematical Methods** Mathematical Mathemat
 - X If your grades are poor you may be denied extension and need to leave Japan, or the extension granted may be very short.



Part-Time Work Permit

Status of Residence

- A "Student" residence status is granted for conducting study and research.
- Any activity other than study or research (for example, part-time work) is considered an "Activity other than that Permitted by the Status of Residence".
- To engage in activities other those permitted by the status of residence previously granted, apply to the Immigration Bureau. If approved, the back-side of your card will be stamped.
 - ※ Working part-time without a permit is against the law.



Part-Time Work Permit

Status of Residence

- The period of the "Permission to Engage in Activity other than that Permitted by the Status of Residence" (part-time work permit) is the <u>same</u> <u>as the period of stay</u>.
- If you extend your period of stay, <u>your previous part-time work permit</u> <u>becomes invalid</u>. Apply for a new one at the Immigration Bureau.
- Hours allowed for part-time work: <u>28 hours per week or less</u>
 (During long vacations (see Academic Calendar), max of 8 hours/day, 40 hours/week)

Work related in any shape or form to the adult entertainment business is strictly prohibited, even just washing dishes or cleaning.

Adult Entertainment Business: "Snacks", night clubs, host/hostess clubs, cabarets, soap lands, pachinko parlors, mahjong rooms, bars/cafes where staff entertain clients and any other establishments related to the sex industry. Even just completing simple tasks such as washing dishes or room-cleaning at such establishments is prohibited. Providing obscene images/videos on the Internet is also prohibited. (These include places where alcoholic drinks are served late at night, places with dark rooms, and those with loud noise indoors.)





Japanese Border Re-entry Permission

Status of Residence

Special Re-entry Permission

By applying for and obtaining a "Special Re-entry Permit" at the airport, you will be able to re-enter Japan using the combination of your passport and current residence card. (Form→)

The validity period of the Special Reentry Permit is up to one year from departure, or if your residence status is valid for less than one year, your residence status expiration date.

Please check the expiration date listed on your residence card before departure.

X A "Re-entry Permit" is available for those who leave Japan for more than one year. It allows re-entry into Japan with the same residence card as long as it is within the period of stay. However, this system is generally not applicable to international students. 15 Further, application is made at the Immigration Bureau, not at the airport.

What International Students need to do

Submit your residence card information



Please submit photos of both sides of your residence card <u>containing your</u> <u>newly registered address</u> by April 10th

Submit monthly attendance confirmation



Whether in Japan or not, after enrollment please answer the attendance confirmation questionnaire in the <u>manaba+R course section</u> every month. You do not need to answer the questionnaire during the long vacations (Aug, Sep, Feb, Mar). Failure to submit the form may result in the following.

- Being reported to MEXT and the Immigration Bureau as a long-term absentee / missing person.
- Losing the ability to receive support from the university, such as issuance
 of documents necessary to extend your period of stay, scholarship
 recommendation, etc.

There are other times when you must report your residence status to the university. Refer to <u>3-2</u> What every international student must remember to do for details.

- When leaving Japan

 Submit a "Notification for Temporarily Leaving Japan"
- When your phone no./address changes → File change on CAMPUS WEB and at Manabi Station 16

Tuition Reduction / Scholarships

Tuition Reduction during your first year

*The current Ritsumeikan University Tuition Reduction Scholarship for International Students will end in 2025. Tuition reduction from 2026 onwards has not yet been determined.

- Tuition Reduction during your first year is as follows.
- Graduate students not selected for 100% reduction when receiving their admission results who want a reduction <u>must APPLY for Tuition Reduction NOW.</u>

Course	Timing of decision for Tuition Reduction
Undergrad	Determined prior to enrollment based on entrance exam scores.
Graduate	Those who want it must apply as soon as they enroll.

 Students who wish to receive Tuition Reduction in subsequent years must re-apply annually. Students may apply once a year, only, according to the schedule here.

September	Late September

Scholarships

 Students may apply at the start of each semester. The postenrollment application period will begin very soon – don't miss it!


